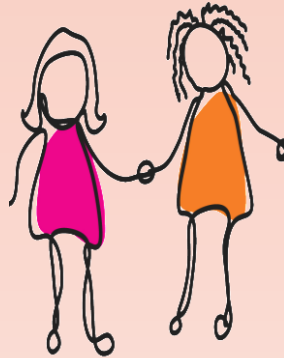

## 9 Tips for Safe Walking

1. NEVER HITCHHIKE OR ACCEPT RIDES FROM STRANGERS.
2. Look left, right, and left before crossing a street.
3. Watch for traffic. A driver may not see you.
4. Wait for the green light to walk. DO NOT cross on the red or yellow light.
5. When the traffic light shows a picture of a person walking it is OK to walk.
6. If you think you are being followed, walk to where there are lots of people like a shop & ask for help.
7. Walk on the sidewalk. If there is no sidewalk, walk on the side of the road facing traffic.
8. Cross streets at crosswalks. If you are inside a crosswalk, cars should stop for you.
9. Always wear bright clothing. Use a flashlight at night. NEVER walk alone at night.



## 10 essential summer tips for you and your dog

- 1) Exercise your dog early in the morning or late at night.
- 2) Use doggie boots.
- 3) Watch for signs of dehydration. Dogs can't sweat. They cool off by panting, so an overheated dog will drool excessively. It will become lethargic, its eyes will be bloodshot, and it may appear a little pale
- 4) Keep your dog hydrated! Always have water available.
- 5) Find innovative ways to cool your dog. Don't have air conditioning? No problem! Find a spot in the shade and set up a kiddie pool. Lay down a wet towel for your dog to lie on. Or simply set up a fan.
- 6) Dogs cool from the bottom up. Make sure to spray the paws and stomach, not just the top of the dog, when spraying it with water. A wet towel does more good on the bottom of your dog than when laid on the top of its coat.
- 7) Let your dog dig! Dogs dig to keep cool.
- 8) Let your dog check the weather. Allow your dog to step outside and feel for itself that it is too hot, too wet, or too cold to go on a long walk.
- 9) Never leave your dog in a parked car.
- 10) Use hot weather as an excuse to swim more often!
